Public Comments

1. Jennifer Valenzuela – Parent choice (regarding masks in schools) is essential
2. Lance Poling – Consider other statistics beyond number of cases when considering mask mandate
3. Frank Foster – What local data will be used to trigger a mask mandate? The authority given to Mr. Brown to implement a mask mandate should be confirmed monthly by the Board.
4. Chris McKee – The virus isn't going anywhere, have parents make the option not to wear masks, look closely at the data – it is flawed, masks might reduce the spread, but not stop it
5. Melissa Pawlikowski – Confirming statement that there was zero transmission when there was 100% mask wearing last year.
6. Paul Sanchez – Have you considered students with special needs who need to read lips?
7. Collin Bradbury – What governmental agency is requiring masks on buses? How long will this go on before things get back together?
8. Dennis Kaps – Any decision has tradeoffs and the board should put kids first – what are the down sides of masks? Nationwide we have lost more children to suicide than COVID. We cannot say for sure when COVID was transmitted.
9. Eric Smith – What choice will teachers and employees have regarding masks?



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10. Kyle Fleck – There are issues with wearing dirty masks or adjusting masks. People walked into the meeting tonight without a mask and then put it on when they sat down. Parents need to make the decision for their children. Requested to show video from Mt. Vernon. The tests cannot detect between the different variants.
11. Aaron McAllister – Nobody has talked about at what point will you say we're no longer going to do this.
12. Carrie Barnes-Mullett – CDC and AAP are recommending universal masking, students K-6 do not have the option to vaccinate and therefore asking for mask mandate in grades K-6
13. Brie McShane – The con of mental health of children should seriously be considered. Are we sending the message that students who are not masked or vaccinated that they are being punished by having to quarantine? Are we actually thinking about kids and families in our community?
14. Julio Valenzuela – If masks are so effective then let them wear masks and don't punish those who choose not to wear a mask. Let parents decide.
15. Kelly Kaps – At a local dance studio, all summer children have not worn masks and have not gotten sick or gotten COVID. All summer has been a test of people who are not vaccinated and are not masked and they are fine.
