Face Coverings Medical Exemption Request

Granville Schools is following state and federal requirements and recommendations regarding students wearing face coverings/masks. Below are the grade-specific expectations:

Students K-3: Students wear face coverings in common areas and hallways inside school buildings and when riding in school-provided transportation, unless an exception applies. Students will wear face coverings while seated in classrooms and will be provided with face covering breaks.

Students Grades 4-6: Students wear face coverings in common areas and hallways inside school buildings and when riding in school-provided transportation, unless an exception applies. Students will wear face coverings while seated in classrooms and will be provided with face covering breaks.

Students Grades 7-12: Students wear face coverings while attending school or a school function in any school building, facility, or other area of a school campus, and when riding in school-provided transportation, unless an exception applies.
Exemptions: Students may be exempted due to documented medical, developmental, behavioral or individualized needs. Documentation for any exemption must come from a professional and be provided to the school district. Face shields will only be allowed as an alternative to face coverings for approved exempted cases.
