GLOBAL SCHOLARS DIPLOMA

- To earn the Global Scholars Diploma, beyond the badge requirements you have already earned, you will...
 - Need to continue to take either the 4th or 5th year of the same language
 - Complete other badge requirements
 - Complete coursework required by the program outside of your regular schedule
- You need to take your second “Global Issues” course in 11th or 12th grade.
- You need to take AP Environmental Science or Environmental Studies in either 11th or 12th grade

NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY

In September, juniors with a 3.5 GPA or higher are invited to apply for NHS. There is a 40-hour community service requirement, in addition to leadership and character components.

The service log and a sample application can be found in Schoology by following these steps:

- **Click on Resources on left-hand side**
- **Click on National Honor Society folder**

ACADEMIC LETTER

- Students can become eligible for an Academic Letter after completion of four full semesters of high school with at least two being completed at GHS.
- Students may apply for the Academic Letter two times a year (Sept. 1st - 15th & Jan. 10th-25th). Invitation to apply sent through Schoology by Mr. Hinton.
- In order to be eligible, students must satisfy four of the five criteria below:
 - GPA - 3.5 or above.
 - ACT or SAT score a. ACT - 27 or higher (minimum of 22) b. SAT - 1290 (minimum of 1120)
 - 3. Attendance - 95% or higher
 - 4. Community Service a. Complete 20 hours of community service
 - 5. School Involvement - Student must meet either the Fine Arts Seal or Engagement Seal

Typical 10th Grade Schedule

- World Literature & Composition or Advanced World Literature & Composition
 - Advanced recommended for a grade of B or above
- Math
- Science
- World Studies or AP World History
- PE and/or Health (if you still need it)
- Global Language (recommended)
- Elective/Other Graduation Requirements (or study hall)

BENEFITS OF AP

AP = Advanced Placement

- College-level courses taught at the high school.
- In May, students will take the AP tests for potential college credits.
- Scores range from 1 (lowest) to 5 (highest). Check with your college/university to learn the score you must earn to receive credit.
- Scores of 3 or better earn credit at all Ohio public colleges.
- Weighted GPA if earn C or above
- Cost is approximately \$97 per exam.

Science Options

- Science
 - Biology/Advanced Biology

 - (Algebra 2 concurrent or previously taken)
 - IAP—Advanced Physics

Online GHS Courses

Summer Ecology/Gardening Course

Must have Biology credit first

Cost: \$ 250

Independent Study (in conjunction with a teacher)—Must be Pre-Approved

Paperwork must be submitted before the end of the school year. Paperwork is available in the counseling office.

MENTORING AND SCHOOL LEADERSHIP

- Freshman participate in this program as mentees
- 10th-12th grade students mentor small groups of freshman
 - Must have a full-year study hall to participate
 - Consists of peer tutoring, transition to high school, study skills training, etc.
 - Worth 0.5 credits for a full year
- Applications available in class tomorrow!
 - Discipline, maturity, essay, GPA
 - Deadline April 5th!

COLLEGE COURSE OPTIONS

- **College Credit Plus—CCP**

- May be taken at GHS, the college campus or online
- Would be at no cost to the family
- Complete and submit *Intent to Participate form* by **April 1st**
- Shawnee State University @ GHS for 11th and 12th
- Off-campus at OSU-Newark, Central Ohio Technical College (COTC), Mount Vernon, CSCC
