

Granville High School National Honor Society Service Log

As service hours are completed and logged below, please remember:

- A student must have completed 40 hours of community service from the beginning of his or her freshman year with at least two non-profit organizations. No fewer than 5 hours can be with any single organization.
- These hours must be completed prior to when the selection application is due.
- The student may count 10 hours of service from a school extracurricular organization such as an athletic team, drama production, or pep band. All extracurricular hours must be completed with an organization that has been officially recognized by the Granville Board of Education, and these service hours still require documentation and a signature. Chorus, strings, and band participation do not count because these organizations are co-curricular, and students earn grades for their participation.
- Family members cannot verify service for the student.

Upon invitation to apply to National Honor Society in fall of the junior year, eligible students will then tally these service hours for submission to the Faculty Council on a separate form. Please simply use this log to keep track of hours and signatures until officially applying.
