Licking County League Coaches Hall of Fame

ELIGIBILITY: The coach should have at least ten (10) years coaching experience in the Licking County League, in the sport for which he/she is being nominated, with at least six (6) years as head coach in that sport. The winning of championships and tournaments should be considered, but not overemphasized. A candidate should be a coach who has rendered outstanding service to his/her athletes and school. He/she should reflect administrative ability to build a program through his/her knowledge of the sport. Active participation in various coaching associations, as well as participation in meetings involving selection of All-League, All-Star, and other special teams that provide their athletes recognition.

NOMINATIONS: Nominations must be submitted on the LCL nomination form to the Athletic Director of the school for which the nominee served. The nomination deadline is March 1 of the year of the induction ceremony. The Selection Committee will consist of the Commissioner, one Athletic Director from each league division, and previously inducted Hall of Fame members. The committee shall review the nominations and submit their choices for approval at the April Board of Control meeting.

AWARD: Coaches who are chosen for induction will receive a Licking County League Hall of Fame ring and a plaque for the honoree and a framed picture for the school for which he/she served. No more than four (4) candidates will be inducted in alternating years when the LCL hosts the LCL/MVL All-Star Football Game as part of the halftime festivities.
